As one of the pioneers in Europe, ebro<sup>®</sup> introduced its first thermometers with digital display in 1980. New products were born at an increasingly rapid pace - watertight handheld thermometers, powered by long-life batteries, the first Temptimem data loggers, high-temperature loggers, precision thermometers, data loggers with display, pressure loggers, a special oil-quality measuring instrument for the food industry, many measurement innovations in the medical field and now the very latest highlights: the EBI 10 data logger with wireless technology for high temperatures and the space-saving EBI 11 miniature data logger, available in Spring 2008.

In the anniversary year of 2008, ebro<sup>®</sup> continues to develop and produce at Ingolstadt with a staff of about 100. Wolfgang Klün, Managing Director at ebro<sup>®</sup> since 1994, summarises: "Our philosophy 'We do it here and we do it on our own' has proved very effective. Proximity and a compact, motivated team provide an excellent climate for innovation."

Today, ebro<sup>®</sup> is known as a world-wide supplier of innovative, hand-held electronic measuring instruments for temperature, pressure, humidity and pH values. Three direct salesmen and two sales representatives in Germany as well as almost 100 distributors outside Germany serve the markets food, pharmaceuticals, chemicals, hospitals and industry.
